On behalf of Georgia Power, Southern Company is filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) an application for a new license for the Lloyd Shoals Project in compliance with the Commission's Integrated Licensing Process regulations at 18 C.F.R. Part 5. The current Lloyd Shoals Project license expires December 31, 2023.

A description of the license application components along with volume locations is provided below. 
