Fees

Some Georgia Power parks, picnic pavilions and overnight camping areas charge a small reservation or parking fee. These vary, so please ask about fees at the site you're interested in.

Park Hours

Georgia Power supervised recreation areas are open to the public 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., Sunday through Thursday, and 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Fridays and Saturdays during the park operation season.

Special Events

Throughout their operational season, some parks from time to time host special events open to the public. These may include music festivals, fishing tournaments, craft shows and holiday celebrations. Individual sites can provide specific information and a calendar of events.

Rules and Regulations

For the safety and well being of all our guests, there are a few rules and regulations that must be observed by all visitors to Georgia Power recreation areas. These are posted at each site. Take note especially of boating and water safety rules. Generally, you are asked to be considerate of other visitors and of the environment. Alcoholic beverages and other intoxicants are prohibited in Georgia Power parks.

Accessibility

Several Georgia Power outdoor recreation facilities are equipped to meet the needs of individuals who use wheelchairs or who have special physical limitations. If accessibility is a concern, please call ahead to confirm whether your needs can be met at the facility you are planning to visit.

Reservations

Campsite reservations must be made at least 10 days in advance and require a two-night minimum stay. You should

specify the type of camping accommodations you will be using — tent, trailer or camper. Reservations are available for the current season.

Picnic pavilions, particularly those for large groups, may require reservations.
