Leslie Sibert is Vice President, Distribution for Georgia Power. In this position, she oversees the company's distribution system, including planning, maintenance, operations and new construction.

Sibert started with Georgia Power as a co-op student in 1982. She has since held various positions at both Georgia Power and Southern Company in retail/wholesale marketing, distribution, customer service, labor relations and transmission.

During Sibert's tenure at Georgia Power and Southern Company, she has been active in numerous organizations, including the American Heart Association, Leadership Gwinnett, Association of the United States Army, DeKalb United Way Advisory Board and DeKalb Chamber of Commerce Board. She is also on the boards of the YWCA of Greater Atlanta, the Georgia Tech Research Alliance Board, the Georgia Tech Women In Engineering Advisory Board, the Georgia Tech Electrical and Computing Engineering Advisory Board, and the Spelman College ASPIRE Advisory Board.
