AVAILABILITY:

Throughout the Company's service area from existing lines of adequate capacity.

APPLICABILITY:

To all electric service of one standard voltage required for temporary service less than 12 months; for recurring seasonal patterns of service; or for the full year operation of other services.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single or three phase, 60 hertz, at a standard voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

Base Charge..... \$21.25
First 3,000 kWh @ 13.3372¢ per kWh
Over 3,000 kWh..... @ 12.1854¢ per kWh
Minimum Monthly Bill: \$21.25 plus Environmental Compliance Cost Recovery plus Franchise Fee

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE COST RECOVERY:

The amount calculated at the above rate will be increased under the provisions of the Company's effective Environmental Compliance Cost Recovery Schedule, including any applicable adjustments.

FUEL COST RECOVERY:

The amount calculated at the above rate will be increased under the provisions of the Company's effective Fuel Cost Recovery Schedule, including any applicable adjustments.

FRANCHISE FEE:

The bill calculated under this tariff will be increased under the provisions of the Company's Franchise Fee Schedule, including any applicable adjustments.

SPECIAL APPLICABILITY PROVISIONS:

Unmetered Service

Where the Company determines installation of metering equipment is impractical or uneconomical, monthly kWh may be estimated by the Company and billed at the above monthly rate. Billing under this option is designated as OGS-9-U.

TERM OF CONTRACT:

One (1) month unless full year operation which requires one (1) year.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

The bill calculated under this tariff is subject to change in such an amount as may be approved and/or amended by the Georgia Public Service Commission under the provisions of applicable riders and other schedules.
