

Dear Mr. Mitchell:

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the referenced documents, which were submitted by Resolute on behalf of Georgia Power Company for the above referenced site. These documents were submitted pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) Act. EPD finds these documents to be complete with respect to the VRP Act and the Rules for Hazardous Site Response. EPD concurs with the Certification of Compliance dated October 29, 2019 that this site is in compliance with Type 3 Risk Reduction Standards for soil for regulated substances associated with releases from this site and that groundwater associated with this site will comply with the purposes, provisions, and policies of the VRP Act through the use of restrictive covenants to be placed on the property. EPD concurs that soil and groundwater on the property identified as Tract 2 is affected by impacts from the adjacent Atlantic Wood Industries site, which is being addressed under Hazardous Site Inventory (HSI) No. 10018.

Once Environmental Covenants (ECs) have been recorded for applicable properties, the subject site can be removed from the HSI. EPD comments on the draft ECs have been provided in separate correspondence. Please provide updated, signed covenants to EPD with documentation verifying that they have been provided to appropriate parties in accordance with the Uniform Environmental Covenants Act. If not submitted by October 2, 2020, please provide a semi-annual status report. Should you have any questions, please contact Michael Smilley at (404) 463-0530.
