



**NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO INITIATE CLOSURE**  
**Rule 391-3-4-.10(7)(d)**  
**PLANT MITCHELL ASH PONDS A, 1 and 2 (AP-A, AP-1 & AP-2)**  
**GEORGIA POWER COMPANY**

Georgia Power Company (GPC) intends to close the CCR surface impoundments known as AP-A, AP-1 and AP-2 located at Plant Mitchell, approximately eight (8) miles south of Albany, Georgia in Dougherty County and Mitchell County. Notification of Intent to Initiate Closure is being made under the Georgia Rules for Solid Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-4-.10(7)(d). Closure of AP-A, AP-1 and AP-2 will be conducted under Rule 391-3-4-.10(9)(c)8 and 391-3-4-.10(9)(c)7(vii), by removing CCR and an additional 6-inches of underlying soil within the CCR surface impoundments. The CCR and 6-inches of underlying soil will be disposed of in a permitted landfill or transported off-site for beneficial reuse. Free liquids within the surface impoundments will be routed to an on-site water treatment system for treatment and then discharged through the facility's National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permitted outfalls. The outfalls are monitored in compliance with the facility's NPDES permit.

By signature below, certification is made that the Plant Mitchell AP-A, AP-1 and AP-2 have received their final load of waste and that closure will be completed by removal of CCR and an additional 6-inches of underlying soil within the surface impoundments in accordance with the requirements of Rule 391-3-4-.10(9)(c)8 and Rule 391-3-4-.10(9)(c)7(vii).
