

Top Tips to Save Energy at Home

Tip: Properly Seal Your Home



Step 1: Check if your weather-stripping needs replacement

- If you see a light where the door meets the jamb, you need to replace existing weather-stripping.



Step 2: Remove existing weather-stripping

- Make sure there is no debris.
- Make sure you have a clean surface before installing the new weather-stripping.



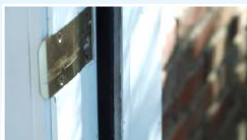
Step 3: Install new weather-stripping

- Guide your hand down the seal to make sure the weather-stripping is firmly attached.



Step 4: Check to see if you have a tight seal

- Check to make sure there is no sunlight coming from the space between the door and the door jamb; or
- Close a piece of paper in the door and pull firmly. Resistance means you have a tight seal.



Step 5: Continue to check the weather-stripping around your house annually.

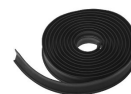
