

Top Tips to Save Energy at Home

Tip: Seal Your Air Ducts



Step 1: Examine ducts for gaps and cracks around connections

- Look for any discolored insulation at the joints.
- Peel back the insulation at the joints if you suspect a problem.
- You can also turn on your system and hold a piece of tissue or ribbon next to the connections. If the material is sucked in, or blown out, there is a leak.



Step 2: Wipe off dust and debris



Step 3: Apply mastic around the leaky connection points

- Use hands, while wearing rubber gloves, or brush.
- Apply until mastic reaches the thickness of a nickel.
- Once it has dried, replace insulation and secure.
