

Top Tips to Save Energy at Home

Tip: Seal Your Windows



Step 1: Examine the outside of your windows

- If caulking is cracked or peeling, proceed.



Step 2: Scrape off old caulk using putty knife



Step 3: Remove any residue, dirt and debris with a damp cloth

- Allow enough time for surface to dry completely before continuing.
- A clean and dry surface is key to making sure caulk sets properly.



Step 4: Prepare the tube

- Cut tip at 45 degree angle with utility knife.



Step 5: Puncture the seal

- Insert long nail or metal coat hanger into tip of tube.



Step 6: Insert into gun

- Position tip at the corner of window trim
- Gently press the trigger while pulling the gun along the seam in a steady, continuous motion.



Step 7: Smooth over caulk with a damp finger

- Wipe off any excess with a damp cloth.
